PARTS OF SPEECH POSTERS:

Noun, proper noun, pronoun, verb, helping verb, adjective, adverb, preposition, conjunction, prepositional phrase, subject, & predicate




NOUN

A noun is a word
person, place, thing

Example: grandmother, house, ball, happiness

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PROPER NOUN

The name of a particular
person, place, organization,
or thing. Proper nouns
with a capital letter.

Examples: Your name, days of week,
cities, towns, states, street, brand


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PRONOUN:

A pronoun is a word used in
place of a noun.


Examples: she, he, it, they, it



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POSTERS INCLUDES: Word, Definition, & Example



PREPOSITIONAL PHRASE:

A prepositional phrase starts with a preposition and ends with a noun or pronoun.


Examples:
From Paris.
With him.
Before the war.



SUBJECT:

The subject of a sentence is the person, place, thing, or animal that is performing the action. The subject tells us what the sentence is about.

Examples: *Dustin* washed the car.
The umbrella is blue.



PREDICATE:

The predicate or verbs explain what the subject does or is doing. The predicate follows the subject and explains an action which is done by the subject.

Examples: The alligator *bites* the log.
The farmer *will* walk.
